Welcome to the 2010-2011 scout year within BSA Troop #1 - Elizabethtown, PA. Troop 1 is one of the oldest troops in the country (celebrated 95 years in 2009). We are an extension of the youth program of our charter organization – Christ Evangelical Lutheran Church.

Troop 1 is very active. We meet every Monday from 6:45-8:15PM (unless specifically canceled) in the A-frame behind the church, and try to have at least one special outing or activity each month. In addition to camping and hiking, Troop 1 has done biking, canoeing, swimming, tubing, and more. Ask any scout about his favorite outing.

Troop 1 is a troop where scouts have fun while learning new skills and leadership. Parents and adults are welcomed and encouraged to support their scouts in a variety of ways – attending meetings, teaching merit badges that apply to an area of interest or expertise, volunteering as a leader, and assisting at fundraisers. Parents may also assist and join in the troop outings of their choice with the permission of the Scoutmaster.

Scout attire: Class B (red tee shirt) is to be worn under Class A (tan colored dress shirt) for all meetings. If your scout would like to wear a hat, he can wear the Troop 1 Class B baseball style cap. For some events, (Court of Honor, parades, flag retirement ceremonies), the full Class A uniform is required (Class B red tee shirt under Class A tan shirt, green scout pants or pants of a similar color, merit badge sash).
